Borough Council and the Hatfield Economic Revitalization Committee (HERC) invite all residents to the first annual "Taste of Hatfield" scheduled for Monday, May 3, 2010 from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. along East Lincoln Avenue in the Borough.

The festivities begin with a Hatfield Chamber of Commerce business card mixer at 4:00 p.m. on the outside patio at Hattricks Sports Bar & Grill. This will be followed at 5:00 p.m. with a ribbon cutting and dedication ceremony for the new Municipal Parking Lot and Liberty Bell Plaza. The Plaza, which is home to the new Verdin Town Clock, boasts 4 picnic tables with benches, decorative planters, a bike rack, and lighting. The "Tasting" event will get underway around 5:30 p.m. following the ceremony. All residents are encouraged to come out and enjoy the tasty morsels from the local eateries in the Borough who will be offering samples of their fares in and around the plaza. Other local businesses will also be on hand to pass out their own literature, pamphlets, information, coupons, and giveaways.
